In 2012, she began her teaching career. She comes to us from Muscogee County, where she taught second grade, fourth grade and prekindergarten.


Her career also includes teaching for the Killeen Independent School District as well as working as a paraeducator in Meridian, MS.

Health Reminders

It's flu season! Please help us keep our school community healthy. The influenza vaccine is important for your child's well-being, ability to attend school and the health of our school community. The influenza vaccine is required for all DODEA students. The due date is December 1, 2023. Failure to provide proof of vaccination will result in parents receiving a disenrollment letter notifying them their student will not be permitted to attend school the following school day, Monday, December 4th. Once the school receives an updated record with documentation of the flu vaccine or an appointment date has been provided the student will be able to attend school.
